## Council Authorizes Amnicola Deed

The Hamilton County Council whisked through a 15-minute meeting this morning, acting on a zoning petition, approving two district roads and authorizing Judge Chester L. Frost to deed the county's interest in 60 acres of land on Amnicola Highway to the state as a site for the new Chattanooga Technical Institute.

The land is part of 75 acres donated by Chattanooga industrialist J. Frank Harrison to the city and county for the new state technical school. Mr. Harrison has already deeded two 30-acre parcels and the remaining 15 acres will be deeded by him next year.

Judge Frost said he and Mayor Ralph Kelley have an appointment with Gov. Frank Clement at 9 o'clock Friday morning in Nashville to turn the property over to the state.

In other business, the council approved a petition of E. K. Scholze to rezone from rural residential and agricultural district to tourist court and motel district an irregular tract containing some 2.42 acres north of Bonny Oaks Drive. The property starts 1,365 feet north of Bonny Oaks Drive and extends north some 465 feet.
