

# CSTCC's Enrollment Reached Record High Of 4,232 In '78

The past year has been one of many achievements at Chattanooga State Technical Community College. Fall quarter reached an all-time high, non-credit enrollment continued to accelerate, new programs were submitted for approval and a special grant to provide expanded industrial training services was awarded to the college.

Fall quarter marked an era in Chattanooga State's enroll-

ment history. More than 4,232 students registered for credit courses during the fall quarter, an increase of 11.3 percent over fall quarter of 1977.

While more than 50 percent of the college's non-credit courses made in the fall, the percentage escalated to a phenomenal 79 percent this winter quarter. This increase came about even with the addition of 13 new continuing education courses.

A new program in inter-preter training was submitted to the Board of Regents for approval and now awaits a decision by the Tennessee Higher Education Commission.

Another building expansion at Chattanooga State is the addition of a Physical Education-Athletic Center. The athletic center should be in use during summer quarter of this year.
