Chattanooga State alters fee plan

Georgia and Alabama residents who work full-time in Tennessee can now attend Chattanooga State as part-time students for the same fees Tennessee residents pay. The new policy, which will start in the fall quarter, was recently passed by the Tennessee Board of Regents, the controlling body of the state's community college system. The program applies only to full-time employees in Tennessee who are part-time students at the two-year college. Course fees for Tennessee residents and Alabama and Georgia residents qualifying for the special fee program are \$17 per academic credit hour, with a maximum charge of \$188. Fees for out-of-state residents are normally \$80 per hour, with a maximum fee of \$904. Students enrolled in less than 15 hours are classified as part-time.
