This guide presents examples of references in APA format for articles found in the library's online databases, such as [MasterFILE Premiere](#) and [InfoTrac OneFile Plus](#). Be sure to ask your instructor for the preferred citation style for your course. A reference for a document found in an electronic database will generally include:

Author's Last Name, Initials. (Date of Publication). Title of Article. *Title of Periodical, Volume Number*, Page Numbers. Retrieved month day, year, from the source database.
